

Event area




Course details:

Two technical and feed zones in place


Assistance building on the paddock area

START LOOP



A 450m start loop will be done on the first lap. (First lap to the circuit includes the start loop)

COURSE ALTIMETRY



Course length: 4.8 km / +altimetry by lap: 140m

FEED AND TECHNICAL AREAS

Two technical and feed areas are defined. The first one at the km 0.3 and the second one at the Km 3.3

Both areas are delimited and should be respected according to the rules in place by UCI and FPC.

SAFETY PLAN

The organization staff will be in direct collaboration with the Vila do Conde authorities, Police and rescue and emergency teams to assure every safety proposal related to the competition and fans assistance.






Campervan parking
